This report summarises the activities of the St Pauls School Cricket Supporters Group (CSG) from May 2011-Aug 2012.

The CSG met eight times since the last AGM. The President attended the SPSSA monthly meetings and the Vice-President attended the monthly BNJCA meetings.

The group held our **Annual Awards Dinner** at the Kedron Wavell Services Club on Saturday 24 March 2012. The guest speaker was former QLD state player and coach, Trevor Barsby. Grant O'Hara was Master of Ceremonies. The SPS Headmaster Paul Browning and his wife Rebecca Browning were our VIP guests. Batting, Bowling and Coach's Awards were made to all St Paul's BNJCA teams and coach's awards were made to all TAS Teams. The evening raised approximately \$4,300, which went towards the 2012 England Tour.

The CSG donated \$18,000 towards the **2012 England Tour**. The parents of players have paid \$75,000 towards of the cost of the tour. The final cost of the tour is yet to be finalised. The Tour took 15 players from years 10, 11 and 12 to Paris, the battlefields of France and Belgium and then onto England to play games against nine schools. The team won the majority of their games. The players were mostly billeted with the families of the players from the schools being visited and also stayed in some of the boarding schools. Several of the families of the St Paul's players were also able to travel to England and watch some of the games. The tour was seen as a great success.

The CSG fielded six teams in the **2011/12 BNJCA competition**. Parents coached and managed the teams and the School provided equipment and the grounds. The U13 Team were Premiers in their

competition. Ryan Walker won the U11 bowling award with both the most number of wickets and the best average for the season. He was also U11 Player of the Round in rounds 1 and 5. St Paul's very successful involvement in the competition was managed by the Secretary and the Vice President.
