1. Business arising from previous meeting held May 2023

Square and eftpos discussion, won't be issues with reconciliation any more as SPSSA has purchased extra squares that are allocated to supporters group. Currently CSG are using Eftpos machine in canteen and it stays there.

2. President's Report

Request to move back to a formal event specifically to honour the firsts, request to ensure event is catered so families can enjoy it together, rather than have to be prepping food etc

More focus on development (esp in junior school), cohesion between JTAS & TAS, coaches and managers for all teams, improve presentation of caps for firsts, more training, new uniforms.

Discussion:

Everything that came through on the survey has already been identified as a focus for CSG and cricket at St Paul's. Dinner event and Term 4 is a good opportunity to kickstart these initiatives.
