School report – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior hockey to have more structured training sessions incorporating assistance from Des Hilton (SPS teacher), in body management. He is also an injury recovery specialist • JTAS Development day and Hook in to Hockey programs well attended with exposure to a lot of students which has transferred to the high volume of JTAS players in 2015 • Great support from Helen Sheppard – Head of JS sport. • G Lang (pre-prep teacher) to come on board as JTAS hockey coach as we now have 5 teams • In collaboration with Westmac, Mr White put a proposal to JTAS for changes to the games. The changes have been adopted. • Mr White is looking to create avenues for MS & SS BOYS hockey • Mr White has made a proposal to HSG for the supply and sale of bucket hats for hockey players, primarily JTAS as it is extremely hot and sunny at this time of the year for the young players 10. General Business- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sam Gray has been working with Mr White, D Southgate and H Mayoh on JTAS. Shirts/water bottles have been delivered • HSG need to purchase an additional 15 JTAS player shirts (10 x size 6 & 5 x size 8) for 2016. • SGray proposed that HSG commit \$ in the budget for the 15 new shirts – seconded by Sue-ellen Rush • Proposed Bucket hats to be organized through the supporter group via flexi schools – cost to be determined once we have what it will cost us – easier for the parents to order and pay. • Mr White provided tour shirt samples for consideration. The committee voted for the collared Razor polo, red with white piping. The embroidery is at a cost of \$6 per shirt • The hoodie is the same as Volleyball (Red). It was decided by the committee to omit the puma • 2015 registration for TAS hockey was discussed. It is available on flexi schools. Mr White 			

will put a reminder on daily notices. S Gray will place the information on the LINK as well as providing a link to the registration form. Sam will also check if something can be placed on the school facebook page as well as providing a hard copy form to Mr White and the committee for distribution

- At present we have approximately 6 players registered in each team (Years 7,8 & 9). No registrations from SS as yet
- Mr White is looking to start SS training in week 6/7.
- The TAS development day is the 19th March 2015
- We have 3 home games this season, with no fundraising opportunities.
- HSG, netball and Year 9 rugby tour are to run a bulk raffle with funds split equally between the 3 groups. S Gray will discuss with R Cox for approval and to be able to allow players to sell the tickets
- SPS are holding the 4 day U18 Touch Football State Carnival and the touch football supporter group have asked the HSG if we would like to share the canteen. The HSG committee agreed to support the proposal
- S Gray is still awaiting information on the Holt Bolt on possible fundraising opportunity
- The hockey bags have arrived. Mr White provided a sample of the embroidery (cost \$7 per bag, emblem and players surname). We have 70 bags, 35 are for the touring party and the remainder will be sold by the HSG as a fundraiser. They will be offered for sale firstly to MS/SS. IF signed on by development day (19/3/15), the cost will be \$50 each (incl school emblem/name).After that date the price will be \$60 each. (incl school emblem/NO name).
- A JTAS parent has reported that the girl's toilets/change rooms are not available for the girls prior to JTAS training at 7am. The girls are unable to place uniforms etc in the change rooms as they are still locked.
- L Pascoe is regretfully standing down as the HSG secretary. M Dunn has kindly offered to take over the duties. S Gray will deal with the correspondence (email).

2015 Tour

- S Gray is liaising with Carrie from Maryborough for games with Maryborough and Hervey Bay over 2 days, followed by a BBQ
- No word from Matthew Flinders as yet
- Bundaberg is still undecided on day one of the tour
- The bus and accommodation bookings are completed
- Mr Hughes has donated the gifts
- Tourist info centre has recommended a boat tour which has dolphin/turtle sighting and afternoon tea. The cost is \$40 per person which is within budget. There is a parent waiver to be signed. Mr White will need to run this past Mr Hughes and Mr Cox. A risk assessment will also be required
- Other touring activities are movies and water park
- Mr White is struggling to recruit female staff members to chaperone the tour. Mr White to confirm the ratio of female teachers to students
