- Des Hilton has agreed to a dedicated training for all years hockey. Des requests that these sessions be combined with Rugby sessions

- All junior teams doing well and the competition flourishing which will promote the longevity of the competition.
- Enquiries now being made in relation to a boys hockey competition for middle and senior school
- St Pauls looking to further the hockey culture being developed in the junior school for boys into Senior and middle years.
- Enquiries being made with BHA and Reggie Fisher Development Officer in Brisbane concerning boy's comps and links between school TAS and Club competitions.

- Samantha has organised a trailer with BBQ, all food provided by the BBQ Trailer and is free

- The trailer gives us the capacity to make Burgers rather than sausages
- HSG to supply drinks, soft drinks are allowed out of school hours

- The final numbers for Development day will be confirmed on 16 March 2015

- The hoodies have been confirmed, they will be available on Development day for sizing. It is anticipated that orders will be taken on this day, including surnames which will be embroidered onto the hoodie

- The itinerary has been finalised, is with the school for approval
- Monday- Boat trip, the price negotiated comes in at \$45 per head which incorporates lunch as well as dolphin/ turtle watching and boom netting
- Dinner and Breakfast is provided by the accommodation on each day of the tour, lunch will be provided by the host schools via a BBQ after the games
- Tuesday- Maryborough, 1 game per each year level + BBQ
- Wednesday -Hervey Bay, 1 game per each year level+ BBQ
- Thursday Gympie, 1 game per each year level as well as canteen and BBQ
- All games should be played on the grass, schools were informed that we are grass teams
- A special rate has been negotiated for Parents that may wish to go, \$109 per night at the Ramada
- Outside expenses are likely to be paid for by teachers and claimed back via receipts.
- The money allocated for the Tour will be provided to cover the costs
- Tim Hughes has given approval for all gifts to be purchased from his budget
- Gifts likely to be plaques for organizer, caps or coffee mugs for coaches,
- HSG to obtain a price for T-shirts with screen printing 2015 Hockey. If reasonably priced voting to committee via email. T-shirts to be given as gifts to captain/player of the match/all team members
- No extra money is required by the students, spending money for incidental of \$50 an appropriate amount
- An additional requirement for students to provide their swimming ability to complement risk assessment for daily beach swims
