Following on from the discussion about The Fair at the last Association meeting and the JSSG's proposal to the School for a covered netball court (referred to as the Covered Multi-Purpose Sports Arena for grant purposes), I have attached two documents. The first is the proposal presented to Dr Browning by the JSSG last September and the second is the successful grant application to the Brisbane City Council. I have included the latter (with Dr Browning's kind agreement) as it covers in more detail the benefits to the broader School community of the project. As mentioned at the last meeting, the next step in the process is to await the outcome of the second grant application to the Gambling Community Benefit Fund. We hope to hear about this in the coming 4-6 weeks.
