General Meeting

Thursday 3 March 2016 at 7.30pm (followed 7:00pm AGM)

Meeting Opened

The meeting was opened at 7.30pm by JSSG President Merita Hammond. Merita thanked all for coming to the AGM and to those who nominated for positions. Merita thanked all those who had stayed for the General Meeting.

Head of Junior School Report

Marianne Connolly noted that this term had flown by and that we are only 3 weeks away from the end of term 1! Marianne reported:

- Thank you Marianne thanked all the new and continuing members
- Busy times lots happening, including year 6 Canberra trip, China tour, sport, incursions and excursions throughout the JS (Peebo and Dagwod, Old Petrie Town, Indigenous Group) and parent teacher interviews
- **Reading café** thank you to all the parents who are helping out with the reading café. It is excellent to see the children developing their reading skills and reading to someone other than their parent's is beneficial
- Easter Hat Parade 24 March prep year 2 (the pre preps do a smaller version of the Easter Hat Parade)

President's Update

SPSSA Constitution amendment: Merita noted that the SPSSA's Constitution had been updated as per a vote on an amendment. Previously, SPSSA membership would lapse (and thus JSSG memberships) annually, however, the change removed this restriction so that now members will remain members for as long as a parent has a child at St Paul's. It was noted that member without current membership or new members will still need to submit a form. The SPSSA businesses (Sippers, Tuckshop and Retail Shop) have been transferred to the school. There will be a transition period of 6 years so the SPSSA can find new ways to generate revenue. The SPSSA is holding a training night in April.

Ongoing communications issues: The CPL role has been amended to accommodate transferring school originated communications back to the school to disseminate. Due to the CPL Coordinator role not being filled at the AGM, all communications (including JSSG communications) will be distributed by Rowena Harle in the JS reception. If there are JSSG communications to go out (eg, for Mother's Day stalls and the like) please CC in Helen so that the JSSG knows what communications are being circulated. Megan Hausmann noted the workload had decreased as a result of shifting the school communications back to the school.



Dylan Malloch has been engaging with the JSSG on the communications issues, which has been appreciated. The school has also engaged and external party to audit communications throughout the JS. Merita advised that once we have the findings and recommendations of the audit, we will readdress the CPL network and Coordinator role.

Volunteer Incentive: Merita noted that the JSSG is exploring the idea of volunteer incentives. The most likely volunteer incentive is a JSSG volunteer car parking space. The exact details are to be determined but conceptually, the carpark would be raffled off. By volunteering at JSSG events, those volunteers would be given one ticket per event. These would then be drawn at the end of the term for the car park the following term. Marianne Connolly and Paul Browning are both supportive of the idea and are happy to give the JSSG an additional carpark for this incentive. The benefits are that it costs the JSSG and school nothing. The incentive will be circulated to the JSSG for a vote once details have been finalised.

School disco: Todd O'Rourke has agreed to organise the disco with the hope that it be held in the new PEC. However, it is unlikely that the new PEC will be available until the end of 2016.

Election day: 19 March – the SPSSA is holding a bake stall/BBQ (Sutton Building). Proceeds from the stall will be divided equally between the supporter groups who provide volunteers to assist. Merita asked if anyone would be available to help. Darsh Chapman, Corinna Sandys-Brooke, Jamie Petterson, Sarah Reilly, Sandra Stanley and Merita Hammond all volunteered time at the stall. Helen Thew volunteered to do some baking. Thank you to these volunteers.
