Japanese	<p><b>Who is your Favourite Pokemon?</b></p> <p>Students learn to describe people and things through the lens of Pokemon. This unit consolidates prior learning of ages, colours and body parts and introduces new adjectives. The unit has a culminating task which is to create their own Pokemon character, label its body parts, name it, and describe its personality and colours.
