5. 2011 SPS season

a) Netball C teams competition

Rowena announced that Tim Hughes has put SPS C teams in the A competition for the Red Division. Only 2 schools in this division are unable to field a 3rd team so C teams will play 6 out of a possible 8 games. Rowena announced that Sally Offer who is currently coaching the 9A team has kindly offered to take on coaching of 9C which has until now been without a coach. She will train 9C on Mondays and Thursday afternoons 3:30 – 5:30pm starting next week. C teams do not have a game this week but will play friendly games between C teams at the PEC centre.

b) Round 5 28th of May (past students versus SPS)

Round 5 all C teams play at home against Rivermount. This round is a bye for all other yr 8-12 netball teams. Tim has advised that he would like to hold a past student vs. current first netball game on this day? start time of 9am, in conjunction with a past student vs. current rugby 1st XV game. NSG has suggested that this go ahead. Claire to ask Chrissie Whyte to check with Boost Juice and Coffee Van for availability. Rowena will send information to Debbie Lever to be sent to past students. Debbie will send email to ask for volunteers for catering purposes. Rowena will confirm numbers with Tim Hughes.

c) Carnivals – SAC (feedback) Toowoomba (25th May)

SAC yr 5-7's 27th of April

St Andrews Anglican College invitational Carnival was very successful. We introduced Yr 5 for the first time this year and this was well received. We were disappointed with the number of SAC students that did not stay on for presentations and afternoon tea. We received positive feedback re behaviour of our students. Plans are underway for SPS to host this next year.

Toowoomba yr 6-7 students travel to Toowoomba, 25th of May

1 Yr 6 team and 2 x Yr 7 teams will attend. The third Yr 7 team will not attend. . Next year it was suggested that we increase the number of teams,

which will attend. It was also suggested that 8C and 7C play friendly game on this date. Permission forms have been organised and will be emailed out this week. Parents are welcome to attend and will be requested to contact Rowena Harle for places on bus.

d) 2011 coaches, managers, PTC (parent team co-ordinator)

All team coaches were confirmed. Rowena has sourced PTC's for yr 4-6 teams. Discussion followed re PTC's for all teams. There is still no PTC for following teams: 8B, 9B, 10A, 10B, 10C and open C's. Claire will email to coaches of these teams asking coaches to follow up with a PTC for their team. For 2012 Rowena agreed, as Head of Netball, she should approach parents directly for the job of PTC.

e) JTAS incl Netta Netball

JTAS games will continue to be played at Cannon Hill. Netta Netball June 11; location tbc SPS only has one yr 4 team. Net Set Go plan to be able to take payments on line next year, which should ensure more security. The year 6 game against John Paul College was noted for the good spirit between the teams. JPC could not field a team so 2 of SPS team played for JPC and they played very well. Also the JPC team included the girls and made them part of their team. Rowena will email JPC and thank them for their support and good spirit. 7C training schedule has changed from Wednesday after school to Wednesday 7:15am before school.

f) Home Game Activities – Coffee Van, Boost Juice, Icy Poles/Lollies –yr5-7

Claire has contacted Coffee Van for home games and is awaiting email; Chrissie has confirmed Boost Juice to be available. Claire to ask Chrissie to follow up on both vendors. Wendy has purchased icy poles from Pick and Pay; with the current special it will save about \$68. She proposed that NSG purchase all but one day's worth for TAS, in case it's rained out to would leftovers; this will be a \$50 saving.

NSG has been given the opportunity to man a drinks station for the Brisbane ½ Marathon on Sunday 5th June. We are looking for volunteers to help out. NSG will receive \$300 to manage this station. Mrs Marianne Connolly will be co-ordinating this event. An email for volunteers to be sent to all.

e) 2012 yr 11-12 tour

The possibility of a netball tour in 2012 for the then yr 11/ & 12 was flagged last term with an email to the families of the current yr 10/11 netballers for an expression of interest re tour by April 11. The school must endorse such an event 12 months in advance. To date only 6 have shown an interest in the tour; all liked the idea of a tour to the north island of New Zealand. Claire will send an email out to all current yr 10 and 11's and await a response. Claire has explored with Tour Time and has a quote for 10 people including airfare of \$3000 each. Erin had expressed her desire to attend; however, Tim has confirmed that 2 members of staff would need to attend and Erin would not be included in the two. Options would be Erin is self-funding which seems unacceptable, the tour costs include her as a third member of staff or she does not go. Application for approval will be made by Rowena. Claire will set up a meeting on 9th of June for interested parents & students+/-current year 12 who toured in 2010. Possible date for tour in 2012 is Friday 21st September, a day before September school holidays.

7. Treasurer's Report

Opening balance is \$5,120.68. There was an expenditure of \$204 (1/2 of BBQ costs) & \$116.68 (MT/lunch/AT) for catering for Development Day, \$160 for food platters for open trials, \$220 for C of A sponsorship, and \$51.95 for voucher fro Emma Whyte. Committed expenditure is as follows; \$420 for Game Day Icy Poles, \$15 for Captain of netball badge and \$47.10 for Netball award 2011. After commitments available funds will total \$3,884.98. Discussions followed re increasing budget for C of A medallions to cover junior, middle and senior school. Claire proposed an increase from \$200 to \$400 to cover this 2nd Jillian. Natasha suggested central invoicing. However, Michael Skinner said all invoices would be sent electronically hence solving the problem of chasing these. Michael Skinner as President of Association will request this on behalf of NSG. Natasha confirmed that treasured report be accepted; 2nd by Debbie..
