5. Reports/Updates

a. Year 9 Tour

The first game of the tour was novel due to being at night and in rain. The team improved with the 2nd, lost by two conversions and then a victory in the 3rd. The accommodation and food were excellent but for 2015 it is recommended that tour organiser request the agenda/menu be more formally documented to avoid last minute changes with request to have adequate food ready for the squad if/when they return from later games. Rugby club in Lennox Head is potentially a good contact. The game seemed to be at the right level, with great referees, good touch judges and first aid. 3 games were felt to be enough, 4 probably too many, particularly with the additional activities. It was estimated the tour was financially secure with over \$20,000 income. While there were a few residual receipts still to be presented it was anticipated income would be in excess of expenditure. The invoice for the bus was anticipated to be via the Association. The Tour gear was well received by the players. Parents commented their children had really enjoyed the trip with feedback all positive noting all students had been well behaved and polite. Ross the bus driver knew the area well and it was suggested a request for him to ne made when booking the bus. Using the school bus provided SPS with excellent promotion. It was recommended to several get guotes for bus as initial guote form St Paul's was guite high. Action: Lisa Jones to confirm holiday dates with School calendar and NSW school calendar

6. Treasurer Report

 - Rugby dinner:-the running sheet was discussed in detail, with thanks to all who had taken on roles in the event. With more than 380 attendees it was anticipated to be an excellent celebration. Thanks to Kimberley for her relentless pursuit of a Reds player and AT for agreeing to interview the guest. Action: Colin to sort metal banners.
 - ii. 2015 Opens Tour:- while all agreed 17 was not an ideal number of players, with the amazing support from the group of players and families who had committed, the 100% support from Tour Time to work with opposition to provide other players if needed and modify the itinerary to ensure three games and 2 elite training sessions the event was moving forward with a volunteer to assist with fundraising. It was flagged that the smaller number of players and the compulsion by SPS for the tour to go in the preseason Easter holidays meant the fundraising opportunities were less and it may be RSG would need to offer a higher level of support as seen in NSG, FSG and CSG to their tours.
 - iii. 2015 Year 9 Tour:- it was confirmed this event was in the school touring policy. Action: Lisa Jones to confirm multiple offers of support and start the process as above
 - iv. Holt Bolt September will be shared by the 2015 Opens NZ tour with the Cricket European Tour. Action: Claire to contact CSG.
