Court Condition/Tennis Shed	<b>Ongoing:</b>  TSG is awaiting the outcome of Go for Gold Grant application (expected date June 2024 as it is deemed a Category 2 Grant). Note – we have since been advised post meeting – the grant application has been unsuccessful.  Awaiting further information school in relation to status of tennis shed location. Belinda will email the school to follow up, cc Karen.
Upcoming dates	<b>Ongoing:</b>  Ash has advised new date for school championships will be Sunday 4 <sup>th</sup> August.  Open Day suggested for Term 4.

5. **President (Alex Mumme)** Alex unable to attend – so has provided notes via email. Queries the court condition – having improved, crack are settling and are less like ledges. Question re: futures first on a Friday afternoon and the ability for other players to attend with assistance from parents.

- Girls First 6<sup>th</sup>, Intermediate Firsts 8<sup>th</sup>, similar results for 2nds and 3rds
  - Boys Firsts 5<sup>th</sup>, Intermediate Firsts 6<sup>th</sup>, similar results for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rds
  - 6 teams for girls and boys, so 48 core players plus fill ins
  - Also, a large contingent of younger boys coming to home games and wanting to learn tennis
  - Rebuilding phase – numbers adequate but still need to develop skills
  - Future first training Friday afternoon – should have reasonable teams next year.
- Notes from SPSSA meeting
- Attendance was low (only tennis, volleyball, dance, football, music, and hockey)
  - No teachers or staff
  - Issues with electronic payments and WIFI connectivity but seems to be solved with hot spotting from phones.
  - Group formed to investigate new structure for SPSSA (like a normal P&C)
  - President role still vacant with no nominations
  - Scoreboard paid for and delivered but has been returned – awaiting updates on replacement
